## Silly Bull Syllable Kit

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Spe	lling	Cheat	Sheet
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Prompts you can give your student to walk them through the steps of Silly Bull Spelling

	"Say the word back."		
	"Are there any prefixes or suffixes?" (student names and places token on the left for each prefix, and on the right for each suffix)		
	"What's the base?"		
	"How many syllables are in the base?"		
	"How many Silly Bulls will you need? What do they say?" (student lays out Silly Bull cards while saying each syllable)		
For each syllable:			
	"Sound it out." (student places tokens on the head, body and tail as they say each sound)		
	"What letters go with that?" (student points to each token and names letter, adding extra tokens if sound has more than one letter)		
	"Write the letters on the Silly Bull."		
	(student uses a dry erase marker to write the letters, saying letter names as they write)		
	"Spellcheck your work." (student goes through a checklist of common spelling problems to check and self-correct)		
	Double, drop and change checks for the join should be added to the checklist as each is taught (if base needs to be adjusted, student updates laminated cards)		
	"Write the base on your paper."		
	(student writes all syllables of the base on paper, saying letter names again as they write)		
	"What word were we spelling?" (remind student if they still need to add prefix/suffixes)		
	"Finish writing the word."		
	(student adds prefix/suffixes to the base on paper)		
	"Read your word back."
