Recipes for "Syllable Soup" Syllable Types

| Recipe Name | Ingredients | Steps | Serves |  |

| Closed Syllable | - 1 a, e, i, o or u <br> - 1 or more tail letters can't be r, w or y | - add to pot <br> - vowel sound is short <br> - soup is orange | makes 1 pot |  |
| Open Syllable | - $1 \mathrm{a}, \mathrm{e}, \mathrm{i}, \mathrm{o}$ or u <br> - NO tail letters | - add to pot <br> - vowel sound is long <br> - soup is blue | makes 1 pot |  |
| Silent-e Syllable | - $1 \mathrm{a}, \mathrm{e}, \mathrm{i}, \mathrm{o}$ or u <br> - 1 tail letter* <br> - silent e | - add to pot <br> - vowel sound is long <br> - soup is blue | makes 1 pot |  |
| Nose Blend Syllable | - $1 \mathrm{a}, \mathrm{i}, \mathrm{o}$ or u <br> - ngornk (update closed recipe that tail also can't be ng or nk) | - melt vowel with $\mathrm{ng} / \mathrm{nk}$ <br> - says nose blend sound <br> - soup is green | makes 1 pot |  |
| Walking Vowel Team Syllable | - 2 vowell letters | - two vowels go walking, first one does talking <br> - vowel sound is long <br> - soup is blue | makes 1 pot |  |
| R-Control Syllable | - vowel <br> - $r$ | - melt vowel with $r$ <br> - says r-control sound <br> - soup is pink | makes 1 pot |  |
| Wrestling Vowel Team Syllable | - 2 vowell letters | - melt vowels into new sound <br> - says wrestling sound <br> - soup is purple | makes 1 pot |  |
| L Blend Syllable | - I-blend <br> - e | - says I-blend sound <br> - must be last syllable <br> - soup is yellow | makes 1 pot |  |

"melt" essentially means that the sounds combine into a memorized sound.

* silent-e does not typically "jump" over ending blends. The exception to this is st (taste, paste, waste), but it's less confusing to generalize the rule and treat this as an exception.
